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1. **Introduction**

Awards Criteria

The revision of the awards system has been done to create greater alignment of the criteria governing the disciplines of Academic, Pro-Arte and Sports Awards. We have also added in two awards to offer more opportunities for acknowledgement.

1.1. **Merit Certificate**

Is to avoid a re-award of a Highly Commended. This award is to acknowledge, more specifically, an improved standard of performance whilst still rewarding a respectable level of commitment and loyalty.

1.2. **Sport or Pro Arte Honours**

Is to recognise and pay tribute to a pupil whose commitment and level of excellence in two different disciplines, within Sporting or Cultural activities, is unquestionable

1.2.1. **Sports Honours**

Awarded to a pupil in Ante-Matric or Matric who has achieved full colours in two different disciplines

In accordance with the colours awards, it is expected that she will continue to represent Roedeans in both of these disciplines until the Matrics are officially relieved of their 1st team commitments in August/September each year

In the event that this is not done, the Headmistress reserves the right to withdraw the colours award which will consequently bring the Honours award into question

1.2.2. **Pro Arte Honours (Public Speaking, Debating, Music, Drama)**

- Awarded to a pupil in Ante-Matric or Matric who has achieved full colours in any two disciplines.
- If the Honours award is given to a pupil for her skill in Music alone, she must satisfy the criteria applying to two different instruments. She cannot, for example, be awarded an Honours badge for Flute Ensemble Colours and the standard Trinity Examinations Colours Award for Flute. Another discipline eg. Choir, Piano, Voice, would have to be offered.
- In the event that a pupil demonstrates exceptional talent in a particular Pro-Arte discipline at National or Provincial level she will also qualify for Honours. In the case of Music, she must have two full colours for Ensemble and Individual music
 - In accordance with the colours awards, it is expected that she will continue to represent Roedeans in both of these instruments until the Matrics are officially relieved of their cultural commitments in August/September each year
- In the event that this is not done, the Headmistress reserves the right to withdraw the colours award which will consequently bring the Honours award into question



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White Blazer

This award remains the highest honour that Roedean can bestow upon a pupil. The following criteria will apply to the award:

- The recipient will have shown throughout her time at Roedean, that she has understood and upheld the values upon which Roedean is founded *Truth, Honour, Freedom and Courtesy*.
- She will have shown commitment, respect and loyalty to her coaches/teachers and to members of her team/ensemble.
- She will also have played a role in serving the school and supporting the community eg. attendance at compulsory events such as Foundation Day, Interhouse events, etc.
- In addition to the above, the recipient of a White Blazer will have achieved:
 - Two Honours Badges
 - or
 - Academic Honours and Colours in one sport and one cultural activity
 - or
 - National selection and representation in a sporting or cultural discipline recognized by the school.

Honours badges and Merit Certificates will be awarded with immediate effect.

White blazers will be awarded on the old system for pupils UV – M in 2015 and the new system will apply to the 2015 LV and MV.

By 2018, the new system will apply to all.



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2. Academics

Academic awards are determined at the end of each examination term.

In Term 2, a Record mark for each subject is determined according to the following formula: $\text{Record Mark} = [\text{Term 1 mark} + \text{Term 2 mark} + (2 \times \text{Examination mark})] \div 4$

Drama Department note:

As the LVs and MVs will no longer be writing Drama examinations, we will weight certain of their tasks during the two modules each year heavier than others. These tasks will be chosen on the basis of being highly rigorous and strongly relevant, so we will therefore use the marks for these tasks as “Examination” marks.

In Term 3, a Promotion mark for each subject is determined according to the following formula: $\text{Promotion mark} = [\text{Term 1 mark} + \text{Term 2 mark} + \text{Term 3 mark} + 2(\text{June examination mark} + \text{November examination mark})] \div 7$

Drama Department notes: Same as Term 2.

Academic awards are based on the **aggregate** for the Record marks (in Term 2) and the Promotion marks (in Term 3).

LV and MV

If no award has yet been received:

- The first time an aggregate of 80% or above is achieved, the pupil is Highly Commended; working towards a Merit Certificate.
- When an aggregate of 80% or above has been achieved in two **consecutive** examination terms, a Merit Certificate is awarded.

After a Merit Certificate has been awarded:

- The first time an aggregate of 80% or above is achieved, the pupil is Highly Commended; working towards Half Colours.
- When an aggregate of 80% or above has been achieved in two **consecutive** examination terms, Half Colours for Academics are awarded.

UV – M

If no award has yet been received, or if a Merit Certificate has been awarded:

- The first time an aggregate of 75% or above is achieved, the pupil is Highly Commended; working towards Half Colours.
- When an aggregate of 75% or above has been achieved in two **consecutive** examination terms, Half Colours for Academics are awarded.

After Half Colours have been awarded:

- The first time an aggregate of 75% or above is achieved, the pupil is Highly Commended; working towards Full Colours.
- When an aggregate of 75% or above has been achieved in two **consecutive** examination terms, Full Colours for Academics are awarded.

After Full Colours have been awarded:



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- The first time an aggregate of 75% or above is achieved, the pupil is Highly Commended; working towards Academic Honours.
- When an aggregate of 75% or above has been achieved in two **consecutive** examination terms, Academic Honours are awarded.



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3. Pro Arte

3.1. Debating

Highly Commended

- Pupil must be in LV, MV, UV, AM or M.
- A regular debater* of a reasonable standard at JUNIOR LEVEL. (Equivalent such as SACEE JUNIOR LEAGUE).
- Represents Roedeans at Interschool Tournaments (Model UN; SACEE LEAGUE).
- Represents House in Annual Interhouse Competition.
- Other factors to be considered: Ability, Service to the School, Sportsmanship, Attitude “on and off the field”, must train regularly and be dedicated.

The pupil must comply with 3 of the above criteria.

Merit Certificate

- Pupil must be in MV, UV, AM or M.
- A regular debater* of a good standard at JUNIOR LEVEL (Equivalent such as SACEE JUNIOR LEAGUE).
- Represents Roedeans at Interschool Tournaments (Model UN; SACEE LEAGUE)
- Represents House in Annual Interhouse Competition; contributes to success of the team.
- Other factors to be considered: Ability, Service to the School, Sportsmanship, Attitude “on and off the field”, must train regularly and be dedicated.

The pupil must comply with 3 of the above criteria

Half Colours

- Pupil must be in UV, AM or M
- A regular debater* of a very good standard for the A team –MUST be involved in the SENIOR SECTION of the League.
- Represents Roedeans at Interschool Tournaments (such as Model U.N. Competition).
- Represents Gauteng A or Gauteng B (Junior team) at National Championships.
- Dedicated, enthusiastic member of the Roedeans Debating Society - must train regularly and support the Society’s Debates.
- Represents House in Annual Interhouse Competition; key member of the team.
- Debating Captain/ Deputy Captain who fosters the love of good debate and extends the Society OR a MATRIC pupil who has significantly contributed to the Society as a debater* for a minimum of 4 years.

The pupil must comply with 4 of the above criteria



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Full Colours

- Pupil must be in UV, AM or M
- A regular 1st Team debater (equivalent such as SENIOR SACEE LEAGUE).
- Represents Roedeans at Interschool Tournaments. (such as Model U.N. Competition ; MUST be at a Senior Level of Debate)
- Participates in Gauteng Provincial Championships.
- Represents Gauteng A or Gauteng B (Senior team) at National Championships.
- Represents House in Annual Interhouse Competition; key member of the team.
- Ranked in top 5 with Speaker points (post Provincial Championships).
- Dedicated, enthusiastic member of the Roedeans 1st Team (or equivalent) - must train regularly and support the Society's Debates.

The pupil must comply with 5 of the above criteria

OR

- Represents South Africa in an international debating event or competition (MUST be at a Senior Level of Debate)

*Note: *Debater = Adjudicator; Floor Speaker; Team Researcher; Chairperson; Trainer/Mentor for Junior Teams etc*

3.2. Drama

Pro-Arte Drama colours are awarded in two categories: Technical and Practical. A pupil needs to accumulate points for Technical work to be considered for recognition in the technical field and she should accumulate Performance points to be recognized in the performance field.

A Matric pupil who directs the House Play can be awarded points in either the technical or the performance field, depending on her point status in both the categories.

Colours are awarded for extra-mural activities only, so that pupils studying Dramatic Arts as a subject are not unfairly advantaged.

Participation in a show in any capacity counts towards the total number of shows for which a pupil can receive an award.

Highly Commended

Awarded to a pupil who has accumulated 15 – 25 points and who has participated in at least 2 shows.

Merit

Awarded to a pupil who has accumulated 26 -39 points and who has participated in at least 3 shows.

Half Colours

Awarded to a pupil who has accumulated 40 -59 points and who has participated in at least 4 shows.



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Full Colours

Awarded to a pupil who has accumulated 60 points or more and who has participated in at least 5 shows.

Points are awarded as follows:

Key:

- HP = House play
- SF = School function
- SP = School play
- SM = Stage manager
- ASM = Assistant Stage Manager

Drama Department notes:

In years where it is not possible to have a school play (as with 2020), participation in the House Plays will be recognised according to School Play points.

3.3 Music and Music Ensemble

3.3.1 Music

Colours will only be awarded from UV onwards – LV & MV are not eligible.

Highly Commended

Pupils may be highly commended if they have successfully met the following criteria:

LV (this will only be awarded at the end of the 3rd Term in LV)

Achieving a distinction in Grade 3 Practical (minimum)

OR

Achieving a distinction Grade 2 Theory (minimum).



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MV (valid from the first Term)

Achieving a merit in Grade 4 Practical (minimum)

OR

Achieving a distinction Grade 3 Theory (minimum).

Merit Certificate

Pupils from MV Onwards can achieve a Merit Certificate if the following criteria are met:

Practical

Grade 5 – Pass/Merit/Distinction (UNISA, ABRSM, Trinity College)

OR

Theory

Grade 4 – Distinction (UNISA, ABRSM, Trinity College)

Half Colours

The Pupil should have achieved one of the following results.

Practical

Grade 6 – Merit /Distinction (UNISA, ABRSM, Trinity College)

OR

Theory

Grade 4 – Distinction (UNISA)

OR

Grade 5 – Distinction (ABRSM)

OR

The Pupil Should have achieved at least Three of the following:

- Active participation in Orchestras outside school, such as the National Youth Orchestra. Principal player in the Johannesburg Youth Orchestra or any Orchestra with an equivalent standard of performance.
- Excellence of performance at the Interhouse Music Competition - 1st place in a category.
- More than 4 consecutive solo performances in the Senior Musical Evening.
- Excellence of performance in the Roedeans Music Competition – prize winner in a category.
- Music participation in a play or musical inside or outside school.

Full Colours

The Pupil should have achieved at least one of the following results.

Practical

Grade 7 – Distinction (UNISA, ABRSM, Trinity College)

OR

Grade 8 – Pass (UNISA, ABRSM, Trinity College)

OR

Theory

Grade 5 – Distinction (UNISA)

OR

Grade 6 – Distinction (ABRSM)

OR



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- Active Participation as a member of the National Youth Orchestra.
- Exceptional National standards of performance, e.g. Winner of Artscape/Philip Moore/Atterbury Piano Competition/Hubert van der Spuy Competition etc.

Re-award of Full Colours

A pupil could receive a re-award of her Pro Arte Full Colours if the criteria under which she received her Full Colours are improved upon e.g. another practical or theory examination of a higher standard is completed. The level of excellence is therefore raised.

3.3.2 Music Ensemble

Awards are based on a points system per Ensemble per year – maximum 20 points per ensemble, per year:

15 points skill

5 points commitment

Highly Commended: 30 Points

Merit Certificate: 60 Points

Half Colours: 80 Points

Full Colours: 100 Points

Points are accumulated annually from LV

OR

From the year when a pupil starts a specific ensemble.

A maximum of 10 extra points could be awarded for participation in a school musical production – participation in International music tours is excluded.

Roedean Ensembles eligible for points include: Choir, Flute Ensemble, Jazz Band, Orchestra, String Ensemble, Rock Band, Marimbas, and Glee Club.

Ensemble Colours will be awarded at the discretion of the music ensemble teacher, in consultation with the HODs, Deputy Heads and Headmistress.

Colours will be awarded to UVs and AMs at the end of the year. Matrics eligible for Ensemble Colours, will receive their Colours at the end of the 2nd term.

A pupil may jump from a Highly Commended to Half Colours, if they are eligible. However, only a Matric pupil CAN skip from Merit Certificate to Full Colours without needing Half colours first, if points permit.

A recipient of full Music Ensemble Colours must remain in the ensemble(s) for which they received colours, for their whole school career. Colours may be revoked if these conditions are not adhered to.



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3.3. Public Speaking

Awards are based on a points system detailed in the table below:

Highly Commended: 11 Points

Merit Certificate: 24 Points (11 points (Highly Commended) + 13 points)

Half Colours: 39 Points (24 points (Merit certificate) + 15 points)

Full Colours: 45 Points (39 Points (Half Colours) + 16 Points)

4.1. Diving

Highly Commended

A pupil in **MV to Matric** is eligible for an award if she has attained the following:

1. 80% attendance at all practices
AND
2. 80% attendance at all competitions.
AND
3. Overall sportsmanship and contributed positively to the Diving Team.
AND
4. Dedicated, committed, supportive and enthusiastic member of the team
EXCEPTION:
5. A LV who has achieved selection for, and **placed in the top 3**, at Junior or Senior Nationals Provincial representation. (Note: Half colours are not awarded in this case, as the LV needs to prove dedication and loyalty towards the School.

Merit Certificate

A pupil in **MV to Matric** is eligible for an award if she has attained the following:

1. 80% attendance at all Diving practices.
AND
2. 80% attendance at all competitions
AND
3. Has displayed good sportsmanship at all times
AND
4. Has shown commitment, respect and loyalty to her coaches and to members of her team at all times.
AND
5. Is a dedicated, committed, supportive and enthusiastic member of the team.
AND
6. Is always prepared to assist members of Staff in any way.
AND
7. Has dived in the diving **team for 2 years** and has shown loyalty to the team and to Roedeans. (They have to have dived in weekly competition at least twice a term)

Half Colours

A pupil in **MV to Matric** is eligible for an award if she has attained the following:

1. 80% participation in School competitions.
AND
2. 80% attendance at all Diving practices.
AND
3. Overall sportsmanship and contributed positively to the Diving team.
AND
4. Dedicated, committed supportive and enthusiastic member of the team.
AND
5. Is always prepared to assist member of staff in any way.
AND
6. Has shown commitment, respect and loyalty to her coaches and to members of her team at all times.
AND



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7. Provincial representation at **Gauteng School's A or B team** or **Senior Nationals level**.
AND/OR
8. Diver must have participated in a minimum of **3 Inter-Highs**, at which she has achieved an average of **25 points per dive**.

Full Colours

A pupil in **UV to Matric** is eligible for an award if she has attained the following:

1. 80% participation in school competitions.
AND
2. 80% attendance at all Diving Competitions.
AND
3. Overall Sportsmanship and contribution to the Diving Team.
AND
4. Dedicated, committed supportive and enthusiastic member of the team.
AND
5. Is always prepared to assist member of staff in any way.
AND
6. Has shown commitment, respect and loyalty to her coaches and to members of her team at all times.
AND
7. **Provincial representation for a minimum of 3 years at Senior Nationals level.**
OR
Placing in the finals at Senior Nationals
AND/OR
8. **Diver must have participated in a minimum of 4 Inter-highs, at which she has achieved an average of 30 points per dive and/or has placed in the top 5.**

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4.3. Hockey

Highly Commended

A pupil in MV to Matric is eligible for an award if she has attained the following:

1. 80% attendance at all practices.

AND

2. 80% attendance at all Hockey matches.

AND

3. Overall, good sportsmanship and contributed positively to the Hockey Team.

AND

4. Dedicated, committed, supportive and enthusiastic member of the Hockey Team.

OR

5. **LV pupils who have represented a District or Provincial U14 team will be eligible.**

Merit Certificate

A pupil in MV to Matric is eligible for an award if she has attained the following:

1. 80% attendance at all practices.

AND

2. 80% attendance at all Hockey Matches.

AND

3. Has displayed good sportsmanship at all times.

AND

4. Has shown commitment, respect and loyalty to her coaches and to members of her team at all times.

AND

5. Is a dedicated, committed, supportive and enthusiastic member of the team.

AND

6. Is always prepared to assist members of Staff in anyway.

AND

7. Has participated in an **A Hockey team for a minimum of 3 years** and has shown loyalty to the team and to Roedeans.

Half Colours

A pupil in MV to Matric is eligible for an award if she has attained the following:

1. 80% attendance at all practices.

AND

2. 80% attendance at all Hockey matches.

AND

3. Overall, good sportsmanship and contribution to the Hockey Team.

AND

4. Has shown commitment, respect and loyalty to her coaches and to members of her team at all times.

AND

5. Is a dedicated, committed, supportive and enthusiastic member of the team.

AND

6. Is always prepared to assist members of Staff in anyway.

AND

7. Selection to a District Team that plays in a **District Tournament.**

OR

Has been an active member of the 1st Hockey Team for **TWO** years.



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Full Colours

A pupil in UV to Matric is eligible for an award if she has attained the following:

1. 80% attendance at all practices.
AND
 2. 80% attendance at all Hockey matches.
AND
 3. Overall, good sportsmanship and contributed positively to the Hockey Team.
AND
 4. Dedicated, committed, supportive and enthusiastic member of the team.
AND
 5. Is always prepared to assist members of Staff in anyway.
AND
 6. Has shown commitment, respect and loyalty to her coaches and to members of her team at all times.
AND
 7. Selection to an U16A/B Provincial Team or U18A/B/C/D Provincial Team that plays in an **out-door tournament**
OR
- Has been an active member of the 1st Hockey Team for **THREE** years.

4.4. Netball

Highly Commended

A pupil in **MV to Matric** is eligible for an award if she has attained the following:

1. 80% attendance at all practices.
AND
2. 80% attendance at all Netball matches.
AND
3. Overall sportsmanship and contributed positively to the Netball Team.
AND
4. Dedicated, committed, supportive and enthusiastic member of the Netball Team.
OR
5. **LV who has been selection to play for U14 School District Team.**

Merit Certificate

A pupil in **MV to Matric** is eligible for an award if she has attained the following:

1. 80% attendance at all practices.
AND
2. 80% attendance at all Netball Matches.
AND
3. Has displayed good sportsmanship at all times
AND
4. Has shown commitment, respect and loyalty to her coaches and to members of her team at all times.
AND
5. Is a dedicated, committed, supportive and enthusiastic member of the team.
AND
6. Is always prepared to assist members of Staff in anyway.
AND



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7. Has participated in an **A Netball team** and has shown loyalty to the team for at **least 3 years**.

Half Colours

A pupil in **MV to Matric** is eligible for an award if she has attained the following:

1. 80% attendance at all practices.
AND
2. 80% attendance at all Netball Matches.
AND
3. Overall sportsmanship and contribution to the Netball Team.
AND
4. Has shown commitment, respect and loyalty to her coaches and to members of her team at all times.
AND
5. Is a dedicated, committed, supportive and enthusiastic member of the team.
AND
6. Selection to U15, U16, U17 or Open District 13 Team.
OR
an active member of the 1st Netball Team for **TWO** years.

Full Colours

A pupil in **UV to Matric** is eligible for an award if she has attained the following:

1. 80% attendance at all practices.
AND
2. 80% attendance at all netball matches.
AND
3. Overall sportsmanship and contributed positively to the Netball Team.
AND
4. Dedicated, committed supportive and enthusiastic member of the team.
AND
5. Is always prepared to assist member of staff in anyway.
AND
6. Has shown commitment, respect and loyalty to her coaches and to members of her team at all times.
AND
7. Selected to **GSSA U16 A/B and/or U18 A/B Netball Team**, which represented Gauteng at the Annual out-door Inter-Provincial Tournament.
OR
an active member of the 1st Netball Team for **THREE** years.



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4.5. Rock Climbing

Highly Commended

A pupil in **MV to Matric** is eligible for an award if she has attained the following:

1. 80% attendance at all practices.
AND
2. 80% attendance at all Climbing sessions.
AND
3. Overall sportsmanship, respect for safety and contributed positively to the Climbing Team.
AND
